New Leadership Class Begins October 9

The 14th Leadership UA Class will convene October 9, at First Community Village. Members of the Board of Trustees and Honorary Board Members will be introduced and join the class for dinner. Program Chair, Matt Rappolt has announced a few changes for the coming year that enhance those begun last year.

A new class titled "Affecting Change" will be taught by three Honorary Board member, Dr. Bill Schaeffer, Senator Priscilla Mead, and Councilwoman Mary Ann Krauss. The class will address the challenges we face when trying to affect change in a community like Upper Arlington and how to go about it effectively.

Returning for an encore presentation is local author and motivational speaker Frank Pacetta. Frank's high energy session left everyone hungry for more last year. Another component is the Leadership Panel that was

very well received last year. The panelists are not confirmed yet, but there is plenty of talent to draw from in this area. The class members have an opportunity to hear how area leaders get the job done and ask advice.

Once again members will be assigned to contact a human services organization and report back to the class about their findings.

The class project will most likely be a single one this year and it will require some cooperation from the alumni. We are planning to have this year's class contact all UALP graduates to determine the effect the program had on your community and volunteer activities. You will be asked about your activities before you took the program and if they changed afterward.

We know this might be a slight inconvenience but encourage you to participate when contacted. The information we gain will be valuable for future planning.
